MILITARY SPECIFICATION

VARNISH, MOISTURE-AND-FUNGUS RESISTANT (FOR TREATMENT OF  
COMMUNICATIONS, ELECTRONIC, AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT)

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-V-173C  
dated 5 November 1969 and is approved for use by all Departments  
and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

Page 1

1.1: Add new sentence, "It provides for two compositions, one of which is suitable for use under Air Pollution Regulations (see 6.9)."

Composition I - General Use  
Composition II - Limited Use (see 6.9)

2.1: Under Federal: delete "TT-P-143, Paint, Varnish, Lacquer And Related Materials: Packaging, Packing, and Marking of" and substitute "PPP-P-1892, Paint, Varnish, Lacquer And Related Materials; Packaging, Packing and Marking of".

Page 3

3.4, delete and substitute: "3.4 Rule 66. When Composition II - Limited Use, material is specified, the varnish shall comply with the applicable provisions of Air Pollution Control District - County of Los Angeles, California, Rule 66 (see 4.6)."

Page 15

4.6, delete and substitute: "4.6. Rule 66. When Composition II - Limited Use, material is specified, the manufacturer shall certify the varnish complies with the provisions of Rule 66 (see 3.4)."

5.1, line 2: delete "TT-P-143" and substitute: "PPP-P-1892".

5.2, line 3: delete "TT-P-143" and substitute: "PPP-P-1892".

5.2: delete "Specification Number" and add "Specification Number and Composition".

6.2: Add: "f. The class of material required".

Page 17

6.9: Add new paragraph: "6.9. Composition II - Limited use material should be specified for use in areas with regulations controlling the emission of solvents into the atmosphere."
