

MILITARY SPECIFICATION

YARN, CORD, SLEEVING, CLOTH AND TAPE-GLASS

The amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-Y-1140H dated 13 Dec 1972, and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

Add to bottom of Page 1:

2.1 delete the first paragraph and substitute the following: 2.1 and 2.1.1:

"2.1 Government documents.

2.1.1 Specifications and standards. Unless otherwise specified (see 6.2), the following specifications and standards of the issue listed in that issue of the Department of Defense Index of Specifications and Standards (DoDISS) specified in the solicitation, form a part of this specification to the extent specified herein."

Under SPECIFICATIONS, Federal, delete title opposite UU-P-268 and substitute "Paper, Kraft Wrapping."

PAGE 4

Under STANDARDS, MILITARY add the following:

"MIL-STD-147, Palletized Unit Loads"

Delete "PPP-B-591, Boxes, Fiberboard, Wood-cleated" and substitute "PPP-B-591, Boxes, Shipping, Fiberboard, Wood-Cleated."

Delete parenthetical source paragraph and substitute the following:

"(Copies of specifications and standards required by manufacturers in connection with specific acquisition functions should be obtained from the contracting activity or as directed by the contracting officer)."

Delete paragraph 2.2 and substitute the following new paragraph 2.2.

"2.2 Other publications. The following document(s) form a part of this specification to the extent specified herein. The issues of the documents which are indicated as DoD adopted shall be the issue listed in the current DoDISS and the supplement thereto, if applicable."

Add the following industry document:

"AMERICAN SOCIETY FOR TESTING AND MATERIALS (ASTM)

ASTM D 3951-82 Commercial, Packaging

(Application for copies of ASTM publications should be addressed to the American Society for Testing and Materials, 1916 Race Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19103)."

Add the following new paragraph:

"2.3 Order of precedence. In the event of a conflict between the text of this specification and the references cited herein, the text of this specification shall take precedence."

PAGE 26

4.1 line 2 and line 4, delete "supplier" and substitute "contractor."

PAGE 32

5. delete "PREPARATION FOR DELIVERY" and substitute "PACKAGING."

5.1 delete in its entirety and substitute the following:

"5.1 Packaging. Packaging shall be Level A or Commercial as specified (see 6.2)."

5.1.2. delete in its entirety and substitute the following:

"5.1.2. Commercial. The commercial preservation of the glass fiber material shall be in accordance with the requirements of ASTM D 3951."

5.2 delete in its entirety and substitute the following:

"5.2 Packing. Packing shall be Level A, B or Commercial (see 6.2)."

PAGE 34

5.2.3 delete in its entirety and substitute the following:

"5.2.3 Commercial. The preserved glass fiber material shall be packed in accordance with the requirements of ASTM D 3951."

5.3 add the following at the end of the sentence "or ASTM D 3951, as applicable."

Add the following new paragraph 5.4:

"5.4 Palletization. When specified (see 6.2), unitized loads, commensurate with the level of packing specified in the contract or order, shall be palletized in accordance with MIL-STD-147. Palletized loads shall be uniform in

size and quantities to the greatest extent possible. If the container is of a size which does not conform to any of the pallet patterns specified in MIL-STD-147, the pallet pattern used shall first be approved by the contracting officer."

6.2 delete in its entirety and substitute the following new paragraph 6.2 and 6.2.1:

"6.2 Ordering data.

6.2.1 Acquisition requirements. Acquisition documents should specify the following:

- (a) Title, number, and date of this specification.
- (b) Material designation (see 1.3).
- (c) Width of cloth required (see 3.2.4.4).
- (d) Selection of applicable levels of packaging and packing (see 5.1 and 5.2).
- (e) When weather-resistant grade fiberboard shipping containers and panels are required for level B packing (see 5.2.2.1).
- (f) When palletization is required (see 5.4).
